Child Care Costs

- Weekly £162 (Day Free)
- Daily £40.50
- Am Session £21.00
- Pm Session £19.50

- A standing order payment system operates for the payment of fees. Fees must be paid in advance
- Children's breakfast, lunch and snacks are included in the fees.
- If a child is absent from nursery through illness, holiday or any other reason the usual fees must be charged to keep your place.
- A review of fees will take place annually, usually in April each year. You will be notified in writing of any proposed fee increase.
- The nursery relies on fees to allow us to operate and non –
 payment of fees will have serious effect on the nursery.
- Preferred method of payments, to keep the cost as low as possible for parents/carers all fees are calculated over 52 weeks. Monthly payment are calculated to make 12 payments over the year. Payments should be made on your child's start date.

Sickness

If your child is unwell or has an infectious illness, you will be asked to keep them at home, or collect them if they become unwell at the setting. We work to the guidelines of the Department Of Health who make recommendations on how long children should be excluded through illness. A full list will be displayed on the parents notice board.

Snack & Meals (included in fees)



We plan our menu of snacks and meals so that they provide the children with healthy and nutritious food. Menu will be displayed on Notice board. Do tell us about your child's dietary needs and we will make sure that they are met.



Children's Clothing

Please dress children suitably for the weather conditions. Please do not dress children in expensive clothing as children are given the opportunity to participate in messy play/ sensory activities and we can not guarantee clothing will not get marked or dirty. Please provide a change of clothes for your child. Welly boots, gloves and hat for cold and wet weather

Sun Protection



All children will wear sun hats which you should provide and a labelled bottle of sun cream.

Accidents



If your child has an accident the necessary action will be taken in line with the nursery Health & Safety policy and you will be contacted if necessary. **Smoking**



The nursery operates a no-smoking policy for all staff and visitors. We would like to request parents/carers refrain from smoking in the immediate area surrounding the nursery.

Additional Classes

Mini Kickers

The children in the Rainbow Room (2-5 years) can enjoy mini kickers every Thursday morning along in the hub sports. Children can participate in obstacles course and games lead by a football coach, this is a cost of £2 per session

Mini Professors

All children in the Rainbow room can enjoy science sessions with Professor Angela.

ICT – Information computing technology
